CUSTOMERS MUST WEAR FACE COVERINGS

All people 10 years and older must wear a face covering when in a business or facility where it is difficult to keep six feet away from other people. Civil or criminal penalty will not be imposed for

failure to wear a face covering.



Face coverings are <u>not</u> a replacement for social distancing,

frequent handwashing, and self-isolation when sick.

Infants and people with health conditions that may make breathing difficult should not wear masks, but should take precautions to socially distance from others.

Cloth face coverings should:

- Cover nose and mouth
- Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
- Be secured with ties or ear loops
- Include multiple layers of fabric
- Allow for breathing without restriction
- Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
